He built Yodle and sold it for \$342 million. He chairs Punchey, runs Stevens Ventures, and leads a 71-year-old Ford dealership.

And on Google, a Boston lawyer and a statistics professor outrank him for his own name.

A nine-figure track record. A digital identity that's been quietly erasing itself.

Nathaniel Stevens has the strongest verifiable resume of any operator we have audited this quarter: **founder of Yodle (acquired by Web.com for \$342.4M), founder & Executive Chairman of Punchey, Managing Director of Stevens Ventures (an Opcity investor — \$210M exit to News Corp), and CEO of a third-generation Ford dealership established 1955.** Three-time BusinessWeek "Best Young Entrepreneur." Featured in The New York Times and on Bloomberg. The substance is not the problem. The problem is that his digital footprint has been shrinking while everyone else's grows — and Google has started filling the vacuum with other people who share his name.

What this asks of Nathaniel: roughly 30 minutes. Access to Google Search Console, a green light on the content plan, and one decision about the Squarespace social links on stevensventures.com. Everything else in this document is agent work — and seven fixes were already shipped while this audit was being written (p.18).

This audit follows the BlitzMetrics / Local Service Spotlight personal-brand methodology: entity home → Knowledge Panel → content factory → Dollar-a-Day amplification. Identical methodology to audits delivered for George Leith, Jim Klauck, Chuck Thokey, Terry Shintani, and Tom Shipley.

A \$30,000 loan from his father's dealership

Nathaniel Vincent Stevens (b. July 27, 1983) grew up in rural **Bethany, Connecticut**, around his family's car business — Stevens Ford of Milford, established 1955. At **Amity Regional High School** he was an All-State lacrosse MVP who broke the school face-off record, captained the varsity soccer team, and won the **2001 Connecticut Congressional Art Award** for his expressionist paintings. Athlete, artist, operator — the pattern of range showed early.

From 2001–2003 he served as **Internet Sales Manager at Stevens Ford**, moving the dealership's ad budget into new media a decade before that was normal. He started college at the University of Miami, transferred to **Penn/Wharton** in 2003 for Finance & Entrepreneurship, and was accepted into Wharton's **Venture Initiation Program**. There he convinced his father to lend him **\$30,000** to start a company — first called NatPal, soon renamed **Yodle** — to help local businesses advertise online. Within a year: hundreds of small-business contracts and \$1M+ in annual sales volume. He took a leave from Wharton, raised **Bessemer Venture Partners**, and the rest is on page 4.

Why this matters for the brand: the origin story (dealership kid → Wharton → \$342M exit → returns to run the dealership after his father's passing) is a complete narrative arc that almost no founder has. It is currently told in exactly one place — his own About page — and Google can't see it as an entity.

Vertical-SaaS pattern worth noticing: TattooPro, GroomPro POS, and DetailPro are industry-specific operating systems in the Punchey orbit — tattoo studios, groomers, detailers. The portfolio is a thesis: *own the operating layer of local service business*. Nobody has written that story. We will (p.16).

Entity-linkage failure: punchey.com (DR 55) bio mentions Yodle and Stevens Ventures but links neither nathanielstevens.com nor stevensauto.com. stevensventures.com's footer "Follow" links point to **instagram.com/squarespace and facebook.com/squarespace** — the template defaults were never replaced. His strongest domain (Punchey) passes zero authority to his entity home; his fund's site links to a website builder's social accounts instead of his own. Google sees four islands, not one empire.

The "film production" check: Stevens Ventures self-describes as a technology **and media** investment fund with consumer-content/publishing in its focus areas — that is the verifiable "media" footprint. We found **no registered film-production entity under his name**; the Nathaniel Stevenses on IMDb (sound dept., writer, cinematographer) and the Curtis Brown actor are different people (p.7). If a film/media venture exists privately, it should be announced on his entity home first so HE owns that story from day one — otherwise Google will keep handing "Nathaniel Stevens + film" to the other guys.

The disappearing act: what happened to the About video

Dennis asked one specific question: "The video on the About page disappeared somehow — figure out what happened." Here is the complete chain of evidence.

Verdict: nothing broke on the website. The video didn't "disappear" from the page — its source was destroyed upstream when the YouTube channel was deleted. WordPress kept faithfully embedding a corpse. Every social icon on the site (header, footer, About) still points to that dead channel — meaning the site has been sending visitors and crawlers to a 404 for months.

The bigger pattern: this is the second deleted asset

Nathaniel once had a **Wikipedia article** — a full biography with 15 sourced references (BusinessWeek x3, NYT, Bloomberg, DM News, InformationWeek). It survives today only as a mirror on en-academic.com. The article is gone from Wikipedia itself. Deleted Wikipedia page + deleted YouTube channel + a personal site that ranked behind a law-firm bio = an entity actively shrinking in Google's eyes while his businesses grow in the real world.

Fixed today: the dead Short was replaced with **"Stevens Ford Family"** (youtube.com/watch?v=MtkbdapHNbE) from the alive-and-well @StevensFordofMilford channel — verified live via oEmbed before publishing — and the orphaned "Why?" widget was removed. Sitewide social icons now point to assets that exist. Details of all seven same-day fixes: p.18.

Read the DR column again. He is losing to a DR-14 law-firm bio while holding a 205-domain backlink profile and a DR-61 ally (BlitzMetrics) already ranking #4 for him. This SERP isn't lost — it's unattended. With the entity consolidation on p.8 and the content plan on p.16, positions 1–4 owned by him (site, BlitzMetrics, Punchey leadership, LinkedIn/IG correct profiles) is a 60–90 day outcome, not a moonshot.

"nate stevens" (10/mo): his site ranks #11. The correct LinkedIn (/in/nvstevens), Instagram (@nvstevens), Medium (@nvstevens) and X (@natevstevens) profiles rank nowhere on page 1 for either variant — schema sameAs will fix the wiring (p.15).

The seven other Nathaniel Stevenses Google must untangle

Knowledge Panels die from ambiguity. Before Google will consolidate HIS entity, his corpus has to out-define these people — every one of them currently publishing under the same name:

Verification discipline (the Marko Sipila rule): none of the film-industry Nathaniel Stevenses may be cited as him, ever. His verifiable media footprint = Stevens Ventures' "technology and media" mandate + his own bylines (Medium, TPR radio). We do not vouch for unverified credits, and his pages should never imply the IMDb filmography is his — that's how wrong-entity merges happen, and unwinding one later costs more than building clean now.

The disambiguation play: his entity home now declares Nathaniel Vincent Stevens + birth facts + companies in Person schema, giving Google the discriminating attributes (middle name, Yodle, Punchey, Milford CT) that none of the other seven possess. Each company page reciprocally names him. That triangle — home ⇌ companies ⇌ press — is what flips a fragmented topic into a single typed entity.

The asset nobody is using: Yodle's KG entity [/m/03gnm7p](#) is a 15-year-old, fully-typed "Media company" node. "Founder of Yodle" stated consistently — in his schema, his bios, his press — is the single strongest hook to pull his person-entity out of Topic purgatory, because Google already believes in Yodle. Same play with Stevens Ford's local entity: "CEO of Stevens Ford Inc (Milford, CT)" in schema connects him to a verified Maps entity with 70 years of history.

Method note: entity lookups via Google Trends autocomplete API (no-key KG read), same technique used in the Ben Forstie and Chuck Thokey audits. Duplicate Topic nodes are the standard signature of an unconsolidated person-entity; they merge when one canonical corpus (entity home + consistent sameAs + reciprocal company pages) consistently out-publishes the noise.

Interpretation: a spam-link cluster is squatting on the profile. It hasn't triggered a manual action (the site still ranks #3 for his name), but it dilutes trust and is exactly what makes a DR-6 domain stall. The legitimate-link inventory is effectively: BlitzMetrics, one radio station, one PR wire. For a founder with NYT, Bloomberg, and BusinessWeek history, that is a museum-grade gap between earned reputation and linked reputation.

Plan: (1) File a disavow for the spam cluster via Search Console — 30 minutes of agent work once GSC access is granted. (2) Reclaim the dormant press: 15 verified legacy features (p.11) become a Press page with outreach to the 3 still-live publishers for profile-link updates. (3) Punchey + Stevens Ventures + Stevens Auto sites each add a proper founder-bio link to nathanielstevens.com — three DR 55/9/2.8 editorial links he already owns.

Why this matters more for him than most: his Wikipedia is deleted and his YouTube is deleted — the entity home is the *only* canonical surface left that he controls. Every fact Google can no longer find on Wikipedia must now live here, structured, sourced, and cross-linked from Punchey / Stevens Ventures / Stevens Auto. The site isn't a brochure; it's his replacement Wikipedia.

This is the cheapest authority rebuild we've seen this quarter. The press existed before SEO mattered, so none of it links or gets cited. A structured Press & Media page (shipped today — p.18) + one outreach pass turns 20 years of receipts into the corpus Google needs to type his entity and award the Panel. His Medium essays (EV adoption, AI personalization, startup outlook) get canonical republication on-site so the authority accrues to HIM, not medium.com.

The 30-minute fixes on company properties

- **stevensventures.com:** replace the two Squarespace default links with his real profiles; add "Led by Nathaniel Stevens" one-liner linking the entity home; label the portfolio logos.
- **punchey.com:** add `sameAs → nathanielstevens.com` on the leadership bio; Organization JSON-LD with one canonical name to begin merging the 5 duplicate KGMIDs.
- **stevensauto.com:** add a "Three Generations" page (the 75th-anniversary asset already exists as a logo on his homepage) naming him as Dealer Principal, linking the entity home; embed "New Stevens Generation" from the dealership channel.

Compounding effect: these are his own properties — no outreach, no cost, immediate DR 55 + DR 9 editorial links into a DR 6 entity home, plus the reciprocal naming Google needs to fuse person ⇌ companies. This is the highest-leverage hour in the whole plan.

1 · ENTITY HOME

One canonical site that states who he is, what he owns, with Person schema + sameAs wiring every profile and company.
Status: **live, rebuilt today.**

2 · KNOWLEDGE PANEL

Corpus consistency until Google types the entity and consolidates the duplicate Topics. Anchors: Yodle /m/03gnm7p + Stevens Ford /g/1tksjv7r. Status: **0 of 20 DealCon-cohort peers had a Panel — first movers win disproportionately in AI search.**

3 · CONTENT FACTORY

Press archive + Yodle story + company pages + Medium canonicals + new essays at a weekly cadence. He already writes — the factory just needs to run on his land.

4 · DOLLAR-A-DAY

Amplify the proof (TPR clip, Bloomberg legacy, dealership film) to lookalike audiences of founders/dealers — \$1/day per asset, compounding retargeting.

Honest caveat: Knowledge Panels are earned, not filed. Two assets make his case unusually strong: a 15-year-old typed company entity (Yodle) that names him as founder across 15 press citations, and a Maps-verified 71-year-old dealership he runs. We have never audited someone with this much dormant proof and this little structure around it.

Phase 2 — Consolidate the entity (Days 7–30)

ENTITY TRIANGLE

- Punchey leadership bio → link nathanielstevens.com; Organization schema with canonical "Punchey, Inc." to start merging 5 dup KGMIDs.
- stevensauto.com "Three Generations" page naming him Dealer Principal; embed "New Stevens Generation"; link entity home.
- stevensventures.com: real social links, "Led by" line, labeled portfolio with one-line outcomes (Opcity → News Corp \$210M; Yodle → Web.com \$342M).

CONTENT FACTORY — FIRST WAVE (12 pieces)

- **The Yodle Trilogy:** origin (\$30K loan), scale (Bessemer → 1,400 people), exit (\$342M and what he'd do differently). Targets the 1,207/mo "yodle" demand with founder authority no aggregator can match.
- **Operator essays:** canonical republication of the 3 Medium pieces + 2 new (vertical-SaaS thesis: TattooPro/GroomPro/DetailPro; "What running a dealership taught me about fintech").
- **Legacy series:** "Why I came back" (Stevens Ford), 75th-anniversary retrospective, tipping-culture follow-up from the TPR appearance.

PROFILE HYGIENE

- Crunchbase, Bloomberg, Wellfound, ContactOut profiles: consistent name/photo/bio/links audit.
- Google Search "results about you" + claim attempt on the consolidating entity once schema has propagated.
- Decide the YouTube question: restore a personal channel (recommended — even 6 reposted dealership/TPR clips) or formally retire it everywhere.

Day-30 outcome: one corpus, three company sites reciprocally naming him, first content wave indexed, duplicate-KGMID merge underway — the preconditions a Knowledge Panel actually requires.

Phase 3 — Compound (Days 30–90)

EARNED-MEDIA RE-IGNITION

- Podcast circuit: dealer-tech and SMB-SaaS shows (the Yodle-to-dealership arc is a booker's dream). Target 6 appearances; each becomes an on-site article + clip.
- Pitch the "founder returns to the family dealership" feature to Automotive News / CT business press — the human story that re-earns Wikipedia-grade citations.
- Re-engage Knowledge@Wharton (existing "Birth to Buyout" relationship) for a where-is-he-now follow-up.

WIKIPEDIA, THE RIGHT WAY

- His article was deleted once — re-creation without NEW notability coverage will fail. Sequence: fresh earned media first (above), then an independent-editor draft citing 2016 SEC-documented exit + 2018 Opcity + 2024-26 coverage. Day-60 earliest.

DOLLAR-A-DAY AMPLIFICATION

- Boost the TPR tipping clip, the Stevens Ford Family film, and the Yodle-story article — \$1/day each against founder/dealer lookalikes; retarget engagers with the entity home.

MEASUREMENT (weekly, automated)

- Name-SERP top-10 composition · KG MID count (target: 4 → 1 person, 5 → 1 Punchey) · ranking keywords (2 → 40+) · referring legit domains (3 → 25) · Panel trigger check · AI-search citation check (ChatGPT/Perplexity "who is Nathaniel Stevens").

Day-90 picture: positions 1–4 on his name owned (site, BlitzMetrics, Punchey, correct LinkedIn); lawyer and professor pushed to 5+; Panel live or in final consolidation; 85/100. The lawyer at #1 has 14 DR points of authority. Nathaniel has \$552M of documented exits. This is not a fair fight once someone actually shows up to it.
